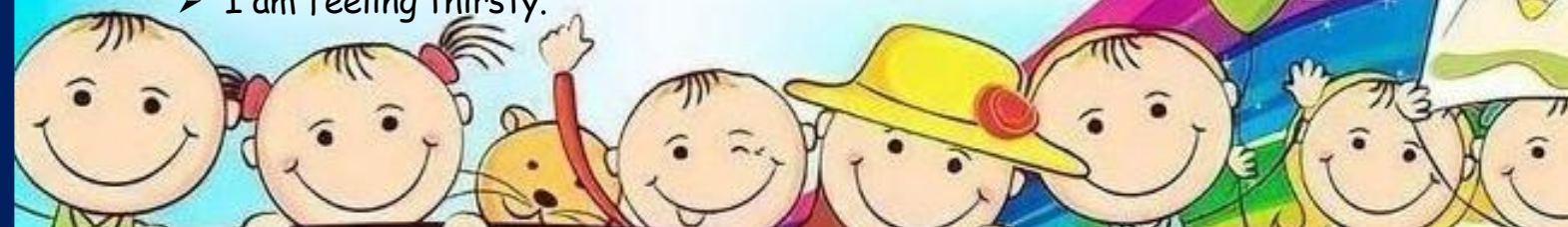

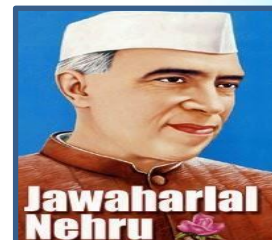

Children will be encouraged to give words beginning with a particular sound (a to z)

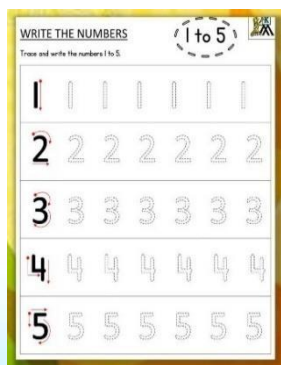


WRITING SKILLS (with pencil)

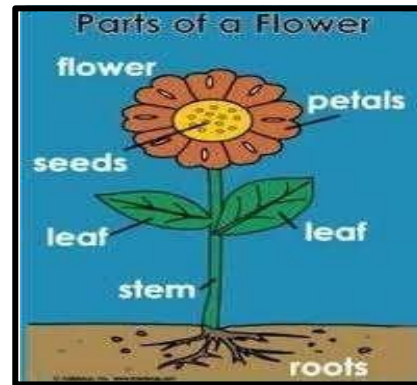

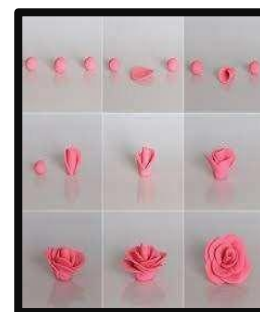

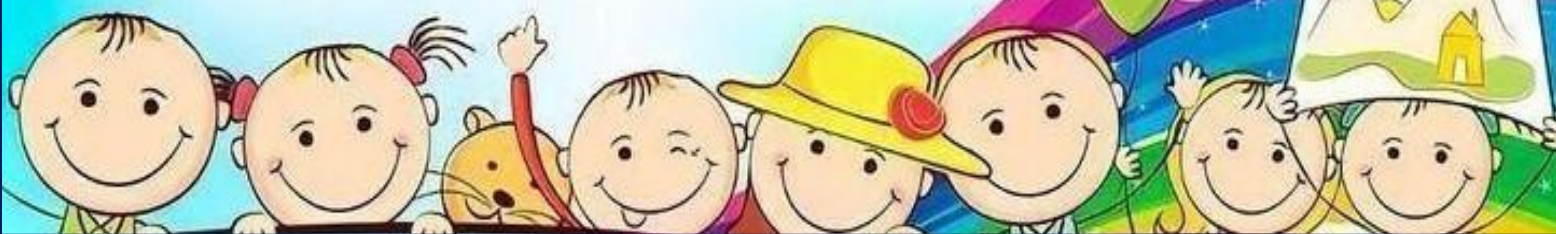
